

The San Francisco/Oakland Bay Bridge Will be Partially Closed Presidents' Day Weekend 2012

In order to complete an essential step in the construction of the new Bay Bridge,

**the WESTBOUND DECK of the Bay Bridge will be CLOSED to traffic
8:00 pm Friday, February 17-5:00 am Tuesday, February 21**

Motorists will not be able to drive on the upper deck towards San Francisco. The lower deck toward the East Bay **will** remain open.

Weather could delay the reopening of the westbound deck or postpone the closure to another weekend.

PLEASE PLAN AHEAD:

- Expect delays and allow extra time in your travel plans
- Use public transit and/or alternate bridges: Golden Gate, Richmond-San Rafael, San Mateo-Hayward, Dumbarton

BART (BAY AREA RAPID TRANSIT)

- BART will run overnight service at select stations during the closure.

- Alameda-Oakland, Alameda Harbor Bay, and Vallejo Baylink Ferries will run additional ferries during the closure.
